

CAD Pest Control Services, Inc. Bed Bug Treatment PREPERATION:

We need access to your box springs and mattress in all bedrooms, or any place that someone is sleeping (couches, chairs, etc.), and the floor areas and carpet surrounding the sleeping areas. Please remove all bedding and clothing from closets and dressers to be treated. **YOU DO NOT NEED TO REMOVE EVERYTHING OUT OF YOUR KITCHEN! We will treat every room and all baseboards and behind furniture in all other rooms.**

- All bedding, including mattress pads, and clothing in affected rooms, must be laundered in hot water and dried in a dryer at the hottest, longest session.
- Remove everything from all of your closets!
- Remove ALL clothing and belongings from dressers, night stands. After laundering clothing, store in your sealed zip lock bags until after the 2nd treatment is completed.
- Pull the ALL FURNITURE AWAY FROM THE WALL, including headboard and mattress
- Please take your headboard apart, so we can treat all cracks & crevices!
- Please vacuum the mattress, baseboards, and flooring around the bed before our treatment, making sure to dispose of the vacuum cleaner bag immediately in an outdoor garbage can.
- Remove all pictures/decorations off wall.
- Remove curtains/draperies & dry or dryclean.
- Please have any and all things picked up off the floor and as clean as possible before treatment. If you suspect any bedbugs inside something, please leave a note for the technician if you are unable to be there for the treatment. **CLUTTERED CONDITIONS WILL INHIBIT US FROM DOING A THOROUGH TREATMENT AND COULD LEAD TO FUTURE INFESTATIONS!!!**
- Please launder all of your clothing in hot water & dry it at the highest setting. Keep the clothing sealed (the large zip-log storage bags recommended) and out of the area for -14 days or until after the second treatment has been completed and DO NOT leave clothing on the floor!!
- Also you can put items in the freezer for 4 days at zero degrees to kill bed bugs. We recommend doing this for items that can be damaged by water (since our chemicals are all water-based, water soluble).
- Remove all light switch plate covers & electrical plug-in covers so we may treat behind them.
- It is REQUIRED that you purchase a **BEDBUG RATED ZIPPING** mattress cover for both the mattress and box springs to stop any bedbugs from getting in or out. These can be purchased at Walmart, Target, or Bed Bath & Beyond. **Make sure it is the kind that zips up CAD PEST CONTROL CAN PROVIDE ONE FOR YOU.PLEASE CALL FOR PRICING.**

AFTER YOUR TREATMENT:

- After each treatment, please allow 1 hour for the liquid pesticide to dry. **Please plan on all pets and persons leaving the home for a minimum of 4 hours.** Vacuum the floor, mattresses, baseboards, 6 hours after the treatment. Please dispose of the vacuum contents or bag immediately in an outdoor trash can. **PLEASE CONTINUE TO VACUUM ON A DAILY BASIS.**
- Please put your bed bug rated mattress covers on, after the room has been cleaned up and is dry!
- At least 1 additional treatment 14 days after the initial treatment is recommended. Depending on the severity of the infestation, other treatments could be recommended by the technician. Please consult with your technician and refer to your infestation & service report.

If you have any sensitivity or a known allergic reaction to chemicals, you must tell us prior to treatment. Please contact your doctor or local emergency room if you do have an allergic reaction to any chemicals. MSDS sheets are available upon request.
